Secure hard drive destruction on-site for \$10. *No tvs or monitors.*

- Laptops
- Servers
- Cell phones & tablets
- Gaming systems & components
- Stereos & radios
- Switches & firewalls
- Printers & fax machines
- VCRs & DVD players
- Remote controls
- MP3 players
- A/C adaptors & other cables
- Ink & toner cartridges
- Rechargeable batteries
- Hard drives (including external)
- Speakers
- Cameras
- Modems & routers
- CD players
- Appliances
- Consumer electronics
- Battery backups
- Keyboards & mice
- ...and similar items

# Items Not Accepted for E-Recycling

- Broken, leaking or corroded batteries
- TVs and monitors
- Items containing mercury (thermostats, thermometers)
- Paint, adhesives, caulk, solvents or thinners
- Items too large to safely handle
- Flammable or combustible materials
- Liquids of any kind
- Pressurized containers
- Household refuse
